Fees paid in this contract are for the breeding of the aforementioned mare only. Substitution of another mare must be discussed and approved by stallion owner and shall require the same pre-breeding exams and testing.

Mare owners will ensure that the mare named in this contract is healthy and in sound breeding condition and free from infection or disease. All mares require veterinary documentation of a recent clean uterine culture and cytology. We strongly recommend that mares undergo a full breeding examination prior to breeding (which includes an ultrasound), AND undergo breeding services in optimum physical condition and weight in order to ensure the highest possible rate of conception.

LIVE COVER BREEDING

Available for Njord Halsnaes, Brigg and Riano. Mares must be insured or injury/mortality, current on all vaccination and deworming protocol, Coggins testing, and present a health certificate upon arrival at Sunnyside Farms. Hind shoes must be removed. In case of any illness or injury to the mare, the mare owner agrees that a suitable course of treatment may be undertaken by Sunnyside Farm's veterinarian, at the mare owner's Expense. Every attempt will be made to contact mare owner before initiating any treatment. The stallion owner shall not be responsible or liable for any accident, illness or injury to the said mare or her foal.

Mare(s) shall be hand bred every other day until the mare is not willing to breed and out of heat. Mares shall be ultrasounded/preg-checked at 15 days post last breeding. If the mare has settled, they will be sent home. If the mare did not take, the breeding will commence again. If, after 3 attempts, the mare does not settle, she will be sent home and the breeding shall be transferred to a different approved horse or a different year.

Dry mare care is \$25/day. Wet mare care is \$40/day

***Live foal guarantee with first 3 attempts. No refunds on booking fee. If mare isn't rechecked (mare owner's expense) at 14, 30 and 120 days for pregnancy, NO FLG will be given.

FRESH/COOLED SEMEN

Available for Njord Halsnaes and Brigg. Two doses (approximately 8 straws each) are shipped after collection at a time that coincides with the mare's heat cycle. The mare owner is responsible for the costs of: stallion owner's hauling (standard round trip hauling fees and time apply), along with the collection, shipping and container rental fees arranged and payable directly to the serving veterinary clinic. Depending on the stallion's location, semen will be shipped by Montana Equine if in Montana or Arizona Equine if in Arizona. Some clinics only collect and ship on specific days of the week. Prior arrangements with the clinic must be made in order to coordinate mare ovulation and semen collection/shipment and insemination.

**An additional dosage fee of \$500/dose if mare needs additional service during the breeding season. \$500 stallion hauling fee applies each time the stallion is transported to the vet for collection. This covers the expense/time of round trip transport, board and stallion handling.

FROZEN SEMEN

Available for Njord Halsnaes, Brigg, Vajeur and Dylan. Two doses (approximately 8 straws/dose = 16 straws) will be shipped from Sleeping Giant Genetics in Livingston, Montana OR Plough Equine in Langley BC. Each dose is considered one breeding. If the mare takes on the first breeding (first dose) and one dose remains, the mare owner agrees to dispose of the remaining semen. The mare owner is responsible for arranging shipment, shipping and container rental fees payable directly to the serving veterinary clinic.

** One additional dose for the same mare during the same breeding season may be available for \$1,000/dose. Additional handling, shipping and container rental fees also apply.

***No live foal guarantee. No refunds on breeding fees. If mare isn't rechecked (mare owner's expense) at 14, 30 and 120 days for pregnancy, NO FLG will be given.

FEES

The total breeding fee is \$2,500 USD. A non-refundable booking fee of \$1250 is due with the return of this contract in order to secure the breeding. The balance of \$1250 is due at the time the **mare is confirmed in foal at the farm for live cover OR before the semen is shipped for AI.** Mare care fee is \$25 per day (dry) \$40/day (wet). Service fee, mare care, vet bills, and any other outstanding fees must be paid before the mare leaves the premises. AI fees such as stallion hauling, collection and shipping are the responsibility of the mare owner and may vary.

Diligent effort will be made to settle the mare. However, if for any reason she does not settle, the Stallion Owner will not be held liable. If the mare doesn't settle by the end of the breeding season (September 1), no future breedings shall be attempted that year. At this time, the mare owner shall forfeit the \$1250 booking fee for live cover and \$2,500 breeding fee for fresh and frozen semen at this time, but may try again the following season with the same requirements and additional fees as stated in this contract.

LIVE FOAL GUARANTEES

Guarantees are given under the following terms: 1. the 14, 30 and 120 day pregnancy checks have been made and documented; 2. the foal is not born to stand and suckle within 3 hours of birth; 3. and a veterinary exam has been done to deem the foal NOT viable, the mare owner shall have an opportunity to repeat this breeding **for live cover and fresh cooled semen only.** Should the mare become ill or die during foal gestation period, another pre-approved mare may be used. Provided a foal is born, standing and suckling, a Certificate of Service shall be provided to the mare owner for the foal's registration. **No other guarantees shall be made.**

REFUNDS

In the event that the selected stallion should die, become lost, stolen, or unfit for breeding (per veterinary inspection) prior to breeding the mare, the mare owner is entitled receive a full refund and this agreement becomes null and void. **In this case only,** the mare owner has the option to transfer this agreement to another stallion with the same or a different approved mare.

This breeding contract is subject to interpretation under the laws of the State of Montana, Arizona and British Columbia. Any disputes regarding it must be brought in a court of lawful jurisdiction in the county of service
